PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Shorecliffs Neighbors and Friends,

Thank you for your support in re-electing me to serve another two-year term on the Board of Directors. I'm also pleased to share that Chris Wade, Frank Wilbur, and Tobias Halbmaier were re-elected, and resident Mel Wygal was newly elected to the Board. They will serve alongside Hal Kolp, Cale Foreman, Matt Rose, and myself. I would also like to thank Alison Anawalt for her dedication and service as Board Secretary over the past two terms.

Our next Board meeting will be held on Monday, April 27, at 6:00 PM, both at the clubhouse and via Zoom. Meetings are scheduled on the last Monday of most months. Agendas and discussion topics are posted at the club and on our website four days before each meeting. We encourage all members to participate by sharing ideas and feedback.

Our goal for 2026 and beyond is to continue representing the best interests of the community while fulfilling our fiduciary responsibility to serve responsibly and transparently. One example of this commitment is our decision to change management companies this year, resulting in savings of more than \$11,000. Those savings allowed us to add lifeguard services on Saturdays, Sundays, and the three major summer holidays – an important priority for our community.

We also hosted a community town hall at the clubhouse with Mayor Loeffler, City Manager Hall, and Planning Commission Chairman Cosgrove. More than 150 homeowners attended to receive updates on the recent purchase of the DMV site. Many residents had questions, and we worked hard to bring the right people together to provide answers.

These are just a few examples of how the Shorecliffs Board of Directors remains committed to serving the community through proactive leadership and open communication. Together, we can accomplish even more.
